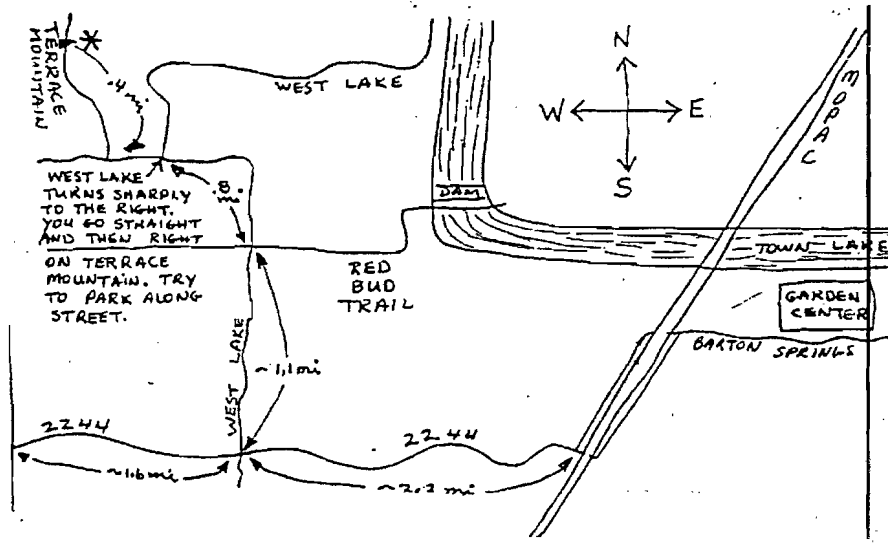

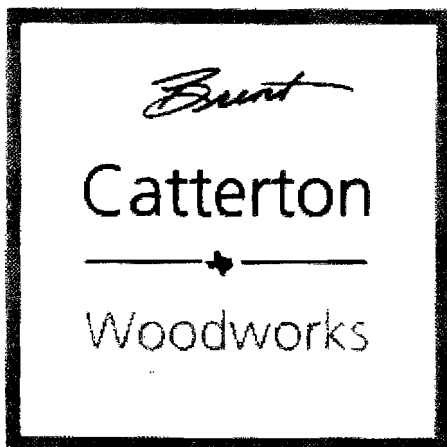
SHOW NEWS

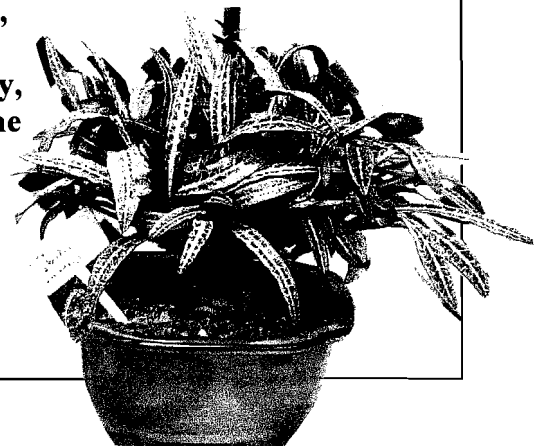
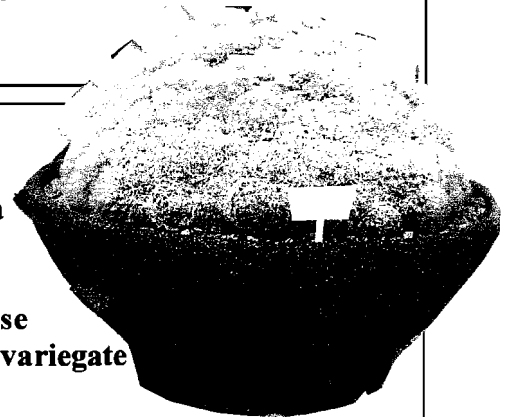
